

# C is for Carson Bengals Football Pillow

This pillow is inspired by my grandson Carson. I changed the Cincinnati Bengals "B" markings into a "C" for Carson. It is knitted in the round and features a seed stitch back. Perfect for watching the game with daddy.

**Finished size:** 18" x 18"

## Materials:

3 balls 315 yds/6 oz. Caron Simply Soft Black

1 ball 315 yds/6 oz. Caron Simply Soft White

1 ball 364 yds/198 g Red Heart Super Saver Pumpkin

26" Circular needle size 8

18" x 18" pillow form or stuffing of your choice

Tapestry needle

**Step 1:** Check your gauge

**Step 2:** Using 2 strands of Black held together, Cast on 74 stitches using the cable cast on method or one of your choice. Join, do not twist, place marker to mark beginning of round.

Note: The front half of the pillow is knit in Stockinette stitch and the back half is knitted in seed stitch.

**Round 1:** K74, (K1, P1) (seed stitch) to end of round (74 stitches) = total 148 stitches.

**Round 2:** K74, (P1, K1) (seed stitch) to end of round (74 stitches) = total 148 stitches.

**Rounds 3-21:** Repeat rounds 1 and 2 for 21 rounds.



## Begin Chart:

**Round 22:** K13, work chart for 48 sts, K13, (P1, K1) (seed stitch) to end of round (74 stitches) = total 148 stitches.

**Round 23:** K13, work chart for 48 sts, K13, (K1, P1) (seed stitch) to end of round (74 stitches) = total 148 stitches.

**Rounds 24-69:** Repeat rounds 22 and 23 until chart is complete (48 rows).

**Round 70:** K74, (P1, K1) (seed stitch) to end of round (74 stitches) = total 148 stitches.

**Round 71:** K74, (K1, P1) (seed stitch) to end of round (74 stitches) = total 148 stitches.

**Rounds 72-90:** Repeat rounds 70 and 71 for 21 rounds

Bind off
